

## 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List

**6 spiral notebooks** and **6 pocket folders** for each of the academic subjects.

One **large package of loose leaf paper**.

**Pencils:** You must always be prepared! Keep extras in your desk. Mechanical pencils are fine. Let's limit "pencil borrowing."

Two **large erasers**. There is no White-Out used in class, do not bring it to class.

**Black or blue pens**. No other colors are acceptable. Pens are used for final drafts and to check math homework. No erasable pens.

One **composition Book**.

A **supply box/bag** to be clearly labeled with your full name.

One **pair of scissors**.

Two **glue sticks**.

One roll of **scotch tape**.

One **box of colored pencils** that will fit in your supply box.

Two **highlighters**.

Two **large boxes of tissues** to be shared by the class.

One **pump bottle of hand sanitizer** to be used by the class.

One **ruler** with metric and standard measurements.

One **small calculator** with a square root button.

One **NIV Bible**. Bibles are available in the office for \$6.00.

**Cloth book covers** for all hardcover books. Books must be covered at all times. Workbooks can be covered with **clear contact paper**.

**\$4.00 for required assignment pad** purchased in the office.

**\$2.00 for required Take-Home Folder** purchased in the office.

One **Spanish-English Dictionary**.

**Music supplies: Recorder, recorder book, and manuscript book.** These must be replaced if you do not have them saved from last year. See Mrs. Turner for prices.
